



## James Wilbur Hall

Mr. James Wilbur Hall, age 79, passed away Sunday, December 28, 2025, at his residence, surrounded by his loving family and under the care of Cornerstone Hospice of The Villages, FL. James was born and raised in Baxley, GA, and after leaving school, he joined the U.S. Army, serving at Fort Lewis, Washington, and Korea for two years, attaining the rank of Sergeant (SGT).
