“ I just found out today that Liston had left this earth. We weren't best friends but we had a bond for over 20 years that few could understand. For 20 years we hunted the same property and for a few months every year for 20 years we would talk and share stories. I was very ill at the time of his death and in the hospital in Savannah fighting for my life. I have not been able to hunt much the last 2 seasons. Today I ran into Darell on the property. I had missed seeing Liston the last 2 seasons because i haven't been able to get in the woods. I noticed the spot he parked for so many years was not being traveled. I figured he had been busy working and we had just missed each other. Darell was parked close to where liston always parked and when he told me he had passed it took a minute to register with me. As I looked over at his spot it hit me like a ton of bricks. For 20 years we had stopped and chatted sometimes 2 minutes and sometimes a hour. We shared stories from hunting to family to work. 99% of the time only he and I knew we had talked. We both watched more deer than we shot and loved the outdoors. We told each other about our growing kids over the years and just enjoyed the fellowship in the outdoors. As I finished speaking with Darell and pulled away and drove by the spot he parked for twenty years I remembered he always had a 2x6 in back of his truck he used to load a deer if he needed it. The leaves had piled up in his parking spot which had not been used in over a year then I realized that a deeply rooted Era of my life had come to a end. I was fighting for my life in hospital while he lost his life and I didn't have a clue until today. To his family you don't know me but liston and I had shared 20 years of our life as friends. I am deeply saddened I didn't know he had passed. He was a great man that was proud of his family worked very hard , he genuinely enjoyed the hunting stories of my children for 20 years and was very respectful and sincere. My deepest sympathies. I have spent the rest of the day reflecting on the stories we shared. Our last conversation was about his job which he had showed me many pictures of masonry jobs he has done which were marvelous. I am sorry for your loss. He made my outdoors experience better for 20 years which I took for granted. I will remember him every time I pass his spot. I will never forget him

and will forever miss our fellowship in the middle of the woods on the edge of the swamp for many years. My heart and prayers are with you guys. He truly made the world a better place
