



## Robert Taylor

Mr. Robert Taylor, age 75, passed away on Monday, April 27, 2026, at home surrounded by his family. Robert was a native of Jeff Davis County, living there most of his life, and later moved to Baxley. At the age of 15, he accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior and later felt the call to the ministry. At the age of 19, he began his ministry as an Evangelist in the Church of God denomination. Robert completed the ministerial Internship Program at the Church of God Campground in Tifton and later became an Ordained Minister in 1995. He served in his church as both Minister and Teacher, having a deep understanding of God's Word, especially prophecies in the Book of Daniel and the Book of Revelation.

Robert had unwavering faith, although he had been sick for over 28 years, he still believed in healing. He often said, "I don't know why God hasn't healed me, but that does not change the fact that God can and God does still heal". He was a Charter Member of Liberty Community Church of God in Hazlehurst. Robert loved God first and his family second.

Preceding him in death are his parents, Elmer "Timer" and Lucille Taylor; two sisters, Waunelle Harrell and Christine Wooten.
