He was preceded in death by his parents, Ralph and Beulah Ford Faught and a sister, Joanne Adams. Survivors include his wife, Donna Lenore Faught; two sons, Steven L. Faught and wife Lisa and Carl M. Waldron and wife Allison; two daughters, Michelle J. Faught and Christina M. Kelleher and husband Ron; eleven grandchildren and six great grandchildren. Funeral services will be held Saturday, May 2, 2015 at 10am at Southside Baptist Church with the Reverend Ben Glosson officiating. Interment will follow in the Hazlehurst Memorial Cemetery.
